

Qualification for End of Year Trophies

- The Knox BMX Club Championship 2024 will be run over 11 Championship Clubby races (subject to cancellations) which can be found on the Knox BMX Calendar.
- All Auscycling Licensed riders can enter Knox Championship rounds and qualify for end of year trophies regardless of what club they are a member of.
- In order to qualify for an award, riders must:
 - Ride a minimum of 5 rounds in any class
 - The rider's family must complete 5 volunteer duties, recorded on a volunteer card. Volunteer cards available at canteen, these must have family name on them and license numbers.
 - The due date for volunteer cards will be advised by the club later in the year
- Awards are presented for each class and the Knox Club Champions will be awarded at the Presentation Day/Christmas Party on December 6th.
- Riders in Novice, Sprocket and Mini Wheelers will receive an award if they qualify, but will not accumulate points.

Scoring

- The points accumulated from all rounds contribute towards final placing for individual classes.
- Scoring for challenge, cruiser and open wheel will be by transponder only. If a transponder is not present or is faulty, the rider will be scored DNF. Transponders are available to purchase online.
- Points are allocated for each Moto & final ranking at all the Championship rounds (see below for details)
- Points cannot be transferred between classes; E.g. if a rider enters 8 Expert Boys and accumulates points, then at another round enter 9-10 Expert Boys these points will not be added together.
- If a class is merged, the points will be based on the class entered prior to merging.
- Points will not be published throughout the year and will be revealed at the final presentation.

Knox Club Championship

- The male and female Knox Primary members with the highest points will be the winners of the Knox Club Championship Award.
- The points from all rounds contribute towards the Knox Club Championship
- Only points from a rider's best overall scoring class will count – points will not be added if a rider enters multiple classes.

General

- All entries will be online via EntryBoss, riders must check in using the transponder checking station by 7pm at each round – riders who do not check in will be removed from moto sheets
- All Sprockets and classes under 12 must run flat pedals only.
- Semi Pro 14 plus must be 14 or over to enter
- Limited classes will be available
- Chief Commissaire has the FINAL ruling
