Knox BMX Club Championship Rules

• The Knox BMX Club Championship 2022 will be run over 10 Championship Clubby races which can be found on the Knox BMX Calendar.

• All Auscycling Licensed riders can enter Knox Championship rounds and earn points towards end of year trophies regardless of what club they are a member of.

• The points accumulated from each round count towards final placing for individual classes.

• The male and female Knox Primary members with the highest points are the winners of the Knox Club Championship Award.

• Scoring for challenge, cruiser and open wheel will be by transponder only. If a transponder is not present or is faulty, the rider will be scored DNF. Transponders are available to purchase online.

• In order to qualify for an award, riders must ride a minimum of 5 rounds in the same class. They also must complete a minimum of 5 volunteer duties throughout the year. Volunteer cards available at canteen, these must have family name on them and license numbers.

• Points are allocated for each Moto & finals at all the Championship rounds. The top 7 out of 9 results are counted. No Number plate or wrong number will be scored a DNF.

• Points cannot be transferred between classes; points are based on the class entered at each round. E.g. if a rider enters 10 Expert Boys and accumulates points, if they then enter 12 Expert Boys these points will not be added together. However, if the class is merged the points will be based on the class entered prior to merging.

• Awards are presented for each class and the Knox Club Champions will be awarded at the Presentation Day/Christmas Party on December 5th.

• Please note: Riders in the Novice class will receive an award at presentation if they qualify but will not accumulate points towards the Knox Club Champion trophy.

• All entries will be online, riders in challenge, cruiser and open wheel must register prior to 7pm via the transponder checking station next to the score shed

• All Sprockets and classes under 12 must run flat pedals only.

• Semi Pro 14 plus must be 14 or over to enter

• Points are published on our Sqorz weekly until Round 6. After that the points are not published in order to prevent the manipulation of results.
